<u>Fact:</u> The klipspringer stands between 17 and 24 inches tall at the shoulder and weighs between 18 and 40 pounds. This small, sturdy, adorable antelope species is found in rocky areas of sub-Saharan Africa.

<u>Fact:</u> Klipspringers have small, cylindrical hooves that are adapted for gripping rocky surfaces. They appear to walk on their tiptoes, which is an adaptation for navigating uneven terrain.

<u>Klipspringer Favorite Cookie:</u> Oreo, likely double stuffed because let's be honest, these guys all seem just a little chubby.


Klipspringer Favorite TV Show: "The Office" Klipspringer Favorite "The Office" characters: Phyllis, Kevin, Stanley





Unlike most other antelopes, the klipspringer has a thick and coarse coat with hollow, brittle hairs. The <u>horns</u>, short and spiky, typically measure 7.5–9 cm (3–3+ $\frac{1}{2}$ in).
