The NFHS reviewed your new product – **Launch Pad Football Kicking Tee**. It was submitted to the NFHS from your company to make sure it complies with current 2018 NFHS Football Rules.

As the liaison to the NFHS Football Rules Committee, who is charged with giving responses to manufacturers' request about equipment, I am writing to advise you that the leadership of the Committee has concluded that your **Launch Pad Football Kicking Tee** does comply with current NFHS Football Rule 1-3-4.

Currently, the NFHS Football Rules Committee does not have any proposals from member state high school associations to change the above mentioned rules for 2018.

You would need to also contact the NCAA to see what their interpretation is for the college level.
