


On Site-Tournament Information

- 1.) We keep 1 official tournament scorebook at the score table. Due to both a lack of space and to eliminate any possible problems with discrepancies there will be no team's scorekeepers at the table. You may keep your book either behind or on your bench.
- 2.) We will also provide each team with a detailed printout of stats from our tournament stat program. As always, we will have copies of both the book and stats available to you following your game and of course we will take care of sending these to all the media outlets. The game stats are also available on the fund's website joshpalmerfund.org immediately following each game for both you and your news outlets.
- 3.) The home team for each game will be the bottom team on the tournament bracket. The one exception to this will be if Elmira is on top then they will retain the home team status. The home team will be in their white uniforms and will sit to the right of the scorers' table facing the court.
- 4.) In the interest of continuity and fairness we will provide 1 tournament game ball for all games. We understand that this may not be the ball your team is familiar with using. Understand that your opponent will be no more familiar with the ball than your team and the ball will provide no advantage for one team over the other.
- 5.) You do not need to bring any basketballs with you. We will provide basketballs for every game and practice.

- 6.) A reminder that we do use a shot clock
- 7.) There will be 3 Officials on every game
- 8.) We request that you provide us with all your media contacts. We are capable and willing to provide all tournament stats and results to all of your media outlets on a daily basis. If we have this information in advance that is helpful. If you prefer to handle all your own media, then please advise us of that as well.
- 9.) Reminder to place game jerseys and shorts (only) in bin for laundry after each game. These will be washed, dried and folded and placed back in your locker room for the next game.

Volunteers will be handling all the items above during all four days. If you have any questions or concerns before or during the tournament regarding these "policies" please feel free to contact me. During the tournament I will always be at or near the gym if have any questions.
