I am requesting a copy of the policy, procedure, or complaint system, which is used by the Norwood Airport Commission or Norwood Airport Manager, NAC/Town of Norwood, regarding all engineering and design services, Subcontract, Program Management, Planning Studies, Feasibility Studies, Architectural Services, Preliminary Engineering, Design, Engineering, Surveying, Mapping, or related services in accordance with:

1. Environmental assessment for the paved safety areas and Taxi Way C relocation.

2. Post monitoring for Taxiway A.

3. Taxiway D relocation.

F. I am requesting copies of the payments to Dubois and King, Jeff Adler, or any firm or person working for Dubois and King, and/or Jeff Adler, for the period January 1, 2015, to the present.
