### MAXIMIZE YOUR TIME ON CAMPUS!

- Schedule your campus visits using pre-arranged visits or contact the admissions office to schedule your own tour
- Plan for your visit by getting a campus map, and highlighting the facilities you want to include on your trip
- Stop by the Financial Aids Office to pick up forms you need to apply for tuition assistance
- Sit in on a class to get a feel for the learning environment and teaching methods for your program(s) of interest
- Talk to a professor who teaches a subject you are interested in
- Talk to students who are currently enrolled in your program as well as alumni and ask them why they chose this school and whether it met their expectations.
- Tour the on campus housing options. Some schools have programs where you can stay overnight to get a better feel for the on campus experience.
- Eat at the cafeteria to see what the food options are like.
- Visit the athletic facilities, library, career services centre, and any other facilities that might be of interest
- If you are interested in playing varsity sports make sure you have a chance to talk to the coaching staff
- Tour the city and campus location to get a sense of the location, what the city has to offer, public transit, and campus safety
