1. Information We Collect

We may collect:

- Name, phone number, email address
- Student-related information provided by parents/guardians
- Documents related to advocacy services (IEPs, evaluations, reports)
- Website usage data (cookies, analytics)

2. How We Use Information

Policy Administrator

- Provide education advocacy services
- Support families in IEP and school-related matters
- Communicate with clients and respond to inquiries
- Improve our programs, outreach, and website

3. Confidentiality Commitment

We care for our families:

- We treat all family and student information with strict confidentiality and integrity.
- We do NOT sell or share personal information.

4. Limited Sharing

We only share information:

- With your written or verbal consent
- When required by law
- To protect the safety of a child or individual

5. Data Security

We implement reasonable administrative and technical safeguards. However, no system is completely secure.

6. Children's Privacy

We work with minors only through parents or legal guardians.

- Access your information
- Correct inaccuracies

1. The messaging program consists of general conversational messaging to answer questions and provide support to customers.
 2. You can cancel the SMS service at any time. Just text 'STOP' to the phone number from which you received messages. After you send the SMS message 'STOP' to us, we will send you an SMS message to confirm that you have been unsubscribed. After this, you will no longer receive SMS messages from us. If you want to join again, just sign up as you did the first time and we will start sending SMS messages to you again.

 4. Carriers are not liable for delayed or undelivered messages.
