Application deadline is August 31, 2026. Applicants will receive confirmation no later than September 12, 2026.
Please do NOT submit payment prior to receiving formal acceptance and completion of the vendor contract!

Vendor spaces are limited! Potential vendors are encouraged to apply early as spaces may fill prior to the deadline!

Our goal is to create the experience of an international bazaar with crafts, art, music, dance, and family entertainment. Children delight in the Kid's Zone and game / play area. Greek delicacies and pastry abound in our Greek Food Court. Greek music fills the air! In 2025 we welcomed over 9,000 attendees over 2.5 days.

Festival Details

Festival Days and Times: Friday, October 16, 2026: 5:00pm – 10:00pm
Saturday, October 17, 2026: 11:00am - 10:00pm
Sunday, October 18, 2026: 11:00am - 8:00pm

Vendor Fee: \$500 for three days includes a 10'x10' tent with one table, two chairs, light fixture, and an electrical outlet.
\$900 for three days includes 10'x20' tent with two tables, two chairs, light fixtures, and an electrical outlet.

Vendor Setup: Begins Friday, October 16, 2026, at 12:00pm. Vendor sale items must remain within the booth area and are not allowed to overflow that specific area.
The festival opens at 5:00pm on Friday evening.
Vendors must clear festival grounds on Sunday, October 18th by 11:00PM.

Vendor Deposit: If you are accepted as a festival vendor, your full vendor fee must be paid no later than September 15, 2026.

Terms and Conditions If you are accepted as a Festival Vendor, the following terms and conditions will apply to your participation in Temecula Greek Festival 2026. Please let us know if you have any questions about the following terms and conditions.

Permits: Vendors must submit a copy of their Vendor's California Seller's Permit to the festival Vendor Coordinator on or before September 15, 2026. If you are serving prepackaged foods you must obtain all necessary permits. Please note that the Riverside County Health Department will inspect all vendors one hour prior to opening. Those without proper permits will be forced to close their booth without refund.

Taxes, Licenses, Fees & Permits: Vendor acknowledges and agrees that Vendor has the sole responsibility for the payment of all applicable federal, state, and local taxes, licenses, and permits for the merchandise sold by Vendor during the Festival. The vendor license must be compliant with Riverside County fire, safety, and health regulations.

Security: Festival grounds are locked each day at closing time. The festival provides security during the festival and overnight on Friday and Saturday nights. However, sponsors, Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, Temecula Promenade Mall, and The City of Temecula, cannot assume any responsibility for any loss of, or damage to, Vendor's merchandise during the festival.

Liability Exclusion: Sponsors, Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, Temecula Promenade Mall, and The City of Temecula, assumes no liability for any claim of personal injury, loss and/or damage sustained by Vendor, Vendor employees and/or representatives.

Required Vendor Indemnification: Vendor shall defend, indemnify and hold Temecula Greek Festival 2026 Sponsor, Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, its officers, employees, volunteers, agents and representatives harmless from and against any claim, demand, suit, loss, cost or expense which may be asserted, claimed or recovered against, and or from Temecula Greek Festival 2026 Sponsor Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, its officers, employees, volunteers, agents or representatives by reason of any property damage, bodily injury or otherwise, of Vendor or of Vendor's employees, contractors, agents or representatives.

Required Liability Insurance: The Vendor must submit proof of \$2,000,000 Liability Insurance to Vendor Coordinator on or before September 15, 2026.

Vendor Requirements: Booth setup must be completed by Opening Time each day.
Vendor may not close their booth before one hour prior to Closing without permission.
Vehicles are not allowed within festival grounds during festival hours.
Vendors must maintain a clean and safe space within their booth.

Extension cords must be grounded type listed for exterior use.

No interior extension cords are allowed.

Interior display lights are permitted if connected by exterior extension cords.

Vendors are required to always staff their booths, unless by prior agreement.

Financial transactions for sale of Vendor merchandise are the responsibility of the Vendor

Festival prohibits the distribution of any political or controversial materials.

Vendors must leave property in the same condition as prior to occupancy or be subject to additional clean-up charges as determined by Festival (\$200 minimum clean-up fee).

Vendors must handle customer complaints in a reasonable, businesslike manner, so as not to bring discredit to St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church or Temecula Promenade Mall.

**Grounds for Removal
from Festival:**

The Temecula Greek Festival reserves the right to remove Vendor from the Festival for (1) unruly behavior including but not limited to intoxication, verbal abuse or threatening behavior to any Festival patron or participant; (2) loud/amplified music or other sounds; (3) contraband, counterfeit, or bootlegged goods; and/or (4) dangerous objects.
