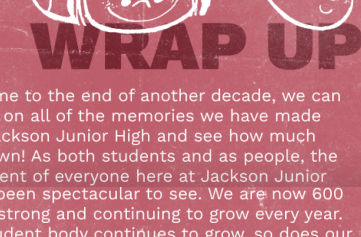

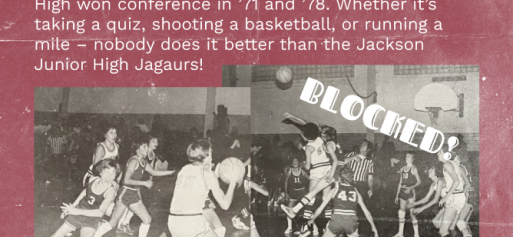
THE END OF A DECADE IN WRAP UP

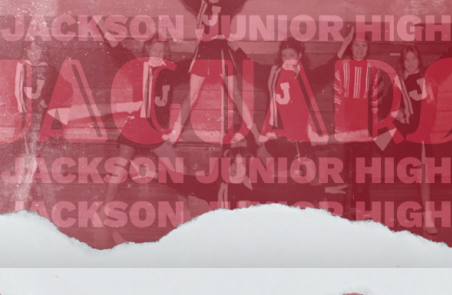

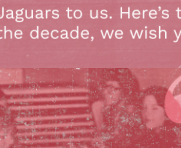
JAGUARS PRIDE!

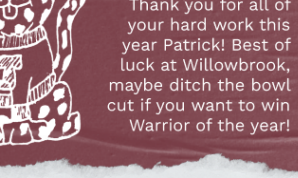
