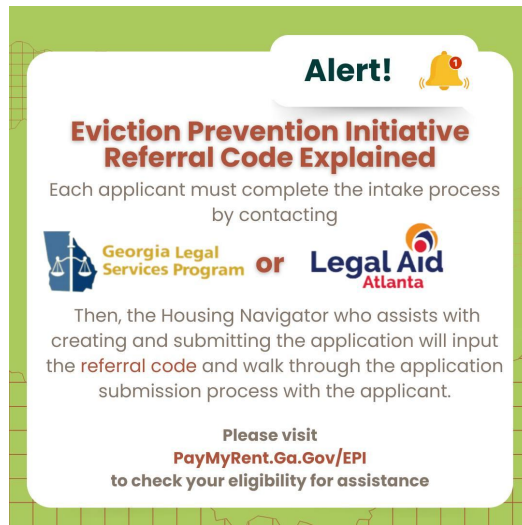


**Facing eviction?**

To apply for rental assistance through the GA Rental Assistance – Eviction Prevention Initiative, please call **1-844-779-3278** on Monday or Wednesday, 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon, except holidays. *Intake for these applications may end before noon on these days depending on call volume.*
