Impact West Georgia (not a shelter)

The Impact Community Weather Shelter is open overnight during *inclement weather* and on scheduled days for resource connections, case management, medical clinics, laundry, showers, and haircuts, etc.

Impact West Georgia has another program, "Men of Hope." HOPE is a holistic, transition program for homeless men who have the personal goal and capability of self-sufficient, independent living and are eager to do the work necessary to achieve their personal goals. The one seeking to become a Man of HOPE must be the one to schedule the interview. HOPE assists men reach their own goals.

As such, it must be the man's choice to become a Man of HOPE, the goals of independent living and housing must be the man's personal goals, and he must both want to do and do the work necessary to achieve those goals.
