Placement at Director's Discretion

Ladies must be pointe proficient

Must sign a season commitment contract

Must be at least 12 years old by June 1, 2027

Ladies must have at least two years of pointe experience

Must be at least 10 years old by June 1, 2027

Must be at least 8 years old by June 1, 2027

Girls/Ladies- Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet slippers/pointe shoes, slick ballet bun, light makeup.

Boys/Men- White leotard or T-shirt, black tights or black bike shorts, white socks, white shoes or black tights and black ballet shoes.

COMPANY REQUIREMENTS:

- All parents and dancers must attend a Company Meeting. The meeting will be **September 13th at 2:00pm.**
- All company member families are **expected to purchase an Ann Brodie's Carolina Ballet Membership**, at least at the Patron Level. Come prepared to purchase a Carolina Ballet membership at auditions.
- **All dancers, if accepted into the company at any level, must sign a binding letter of commitment to all Ann Brodie's Carolina Ballet productions and activities for the season, including the Summer Academy. Payment to be allocated for one week of the required Summer Academy, June 7-11 and 14-18, is due by March 1, 2027.**
- Senior Ensemble and Senior Company Members must take a minimum of five ballet classes and one enrichment class per week, or other genres of classes approved by the Artistic Director. Individual company members must meet with the Artistic Director for this approval.
- Junior Company Members are expected to take a minimum of three ballet classes per week approved by the Artistic Director.
- Junior Apprentice Members are expected to take a minimum of two ballet classes per week approved by the Artistic Director.

Auditions are conducted under the direction of John Whitehead, Executive Director and Mimi Worrell, Artistic Director. Ann Brodie's Carolina Ballet is open to all qualified dancers through open auditions.
