## **ICT** portal

## The ICT portal provides 4 levels of training

**Level 1** – Understand IC theory and method; input via **Decision Tree** to develop bespoke IC intervention for context.

**Level 2** – Facilitator Training – using demo film clips per activity. Pilot inhouse the new IC intervention, observed via Zoom, with feedback and Certification.

Measurement module – select measurement tools and learn how to use the ICT Portal to use Pre and Post testing, with **Al-assisted IC coding and reporting**.

Level 3 – Trainers of Facilitators – train new facilitators to expand your roll out.

**Level 4** – Learn to adapt your course to extend its reach to additional contexts.

Pre and post testing results have shown the training materials are as effective as in-person training.

The ICT portal enables engagement between Client organisations and a Senior IC Consultant through Zoom interactions (at least one Zoom per level of training).

## Client organisation users of the ICT portal will likely be:

- NGOs, education, community, government organisations, or university researchers
- involved in CVE, PVE, PVE-Education (critical thinking courses), community cohesion and peacebuilding
- who have a set of 4 or more potential facilitators who are already experienced in group work interventions in their context and have PSS psycho-social training as a minimum, and who will work under the client organisation's management.
