
- We have shared rules




Family/ community and schools are a social system


<u>1. Family or community</u> - Write on post-it notes, such as Father, Leader, Brother, Neighbour, Uncle, Mother ...





Golden age of Islam and science 800-1300




Thinking changes over the

Golden Age of Islam and Science -Islamic scholars make huge scientific advances 800-1300 CE








Family, teacher, imams each have different viewpoints







Ali seeks to understand their important value priorities
