

The Atonement

The Exchange that Takes Place at the Cross

(As you declare the exchange that takes place at the cross you need to realize how saved you are. The following information is taken from Derek Prince's book entitled Atonement.)

1. *Is. 53:4-5* Jesus was punished so that we might be **forgiven**.
2. *Is. 53:4-5; I Peter 2:24* Jesus was wounded that we might be **healed**.
3. *Is. 53:10; Is. 61: 10; II Corinthians 5:21* Jesus was made sin with our sinfulness that we might be made **righteous** with His righteousness (justified).
4. *Hebrews 2:9* Jesus died our death that we might **share His life**.
5. *Galatians 3:13-14; Ephesians 1:3* Jesus was made a curse that we might receive the **blessing**.
6. *II Corinthians 8:9; 9:8* Jesus endured our poverty that we might **share His abundance**.
7. *Matthew 27:35-36, Hebrews 12:2; 2:9* Jesus bore our shame that we might **share His glory**.
8. *Matthew 27:46-51; Ephesians 1:5-6* Jesus endured our rejection that we might **enjoy His acceptance**.
9. *Isaiah 53:8; I Corinthians 6:17* Jesus was cut off by death that we might be **joined to God eternally**.
10. *Romans 6:6; Colossians 3:9-10* Our old man died in Jesus that the **new man** might **live in us**.

Thank Jesus Christ for His Provision

(The simplest way to appropriate or receive all that Jesus Christ has done for you on the cross is to thank Him for it through the confession of your mouth.)

1. Thank-You Jesus that You have **forgiven me**.
2. Thank-You Jesus that You have **healed me**.
3. Thank-You Jesus that You have **made me righteous**, just as if I have never sinned.
4. Thank-You Jesus that You have died my death so that I now **share Your life**.
5. Thank-You Jesus that You have **redeemed me from the curse and have blessed me** with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places.
6. Thank-You Jesus that You have **given me Your abundance**.
7. Thank-You Jesus that You have bore my shame and **released me from it**, allowing me to **share in Your glory** in this life and in the next.
8. Thank-You Jesus that You have **accepted me in the beloved**. Thank You for being my Father and for accepting me into your family.
9. Thank-You that You allow nothing to separate me from You, having **joined me to You eternally**.
10. Thank-You that You have **made me a new creation**.

Communion

I Corinthians 11:23-24 "and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me. In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me."

When Christ tells you to take His body and drink His blood in remembrance of Him, He wants you to recognize and accept, "to take", everything that He has provided for you. You "take and eat" in a worthy manner when you choose to believe that His full forgiveness, His complete healing, His total acceptance, and His full redemption and provision listed above is for you at this present moment. This faith is not based on what you feel or what you see, but in what Christ has already done for you. Examine yourself as to whether you have faith in His full provision for your life today.

"For by grace you have been saved (forgiven, healed...) through faith (in what Christ has done for you) and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." Eph. 2:8-9
