

In September it was announced that the PAEP needed urgent repairs carried out to replace 2 copper waste pipes and some asbestos needed to be removed for the work to be carried out safely. A decision was made that the building would need to be closed for six months so that the work could be carriesd out safely. Staff were given four weeks notice of this decision. The PAEP has one of the busiest outpatient departments in Lothian. The UNISON Corporate team ensured they were on site day and night regularly over the very short period of time from the announcement to the closure date at the end of October to keep staff up to date and support them through this process. We ensured the move to their new premises was as smooth as possible for staff and that all staff did not face any changes to their conditions of employment.



The NAAFI Break has been created to rekindle and foster the sense of camaraderie found within the Armed Forces.






