

HMA Sanitation Protocol

Our goal in maintaining a high quality sanitation protocol is to ensure the safety of our students, campers, and parents. We also hope to encourage good sanitation and hygiene habits to all members by leading by example and help them understand the purpose of such practices.

- Parents will drop off campers by the front door
- Camper temperature will be scanned via no-touch digital thermometer.
- If camper shows any signs or symptoms of illness they will not be allowed to take part in camp in any shape or manner. **If you know they have been feeling ill please do not bring them.**
- Campers are required to wash their hands upon entering and putting away their belongings (after eating, after using the bathroom, and after returning from any trips)
 - Camper should have their OWN personal sanitizer for occasions such as field trips.
- If at any time a camper shows any signs or symptoms of sickness during camp they will be separated from all other campers, parents will be contacted, and will remain further socially distant from other campers until they are picked up by parent or guardian.
- High contact surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected twice every day: mid-day, before afternoon activities, and at the end of the day after closing. Areas include all door handles, desks, chairs, couches, any equipment used, and bathroom. Hard surfaces will be cleaned and wiped with disinfectant solution and soft surfaces (couches) will be sprayed down with disinfectant spray.
 - Campers will be either outside, in preparation for field trips, or in the other section of the building (dojang area or front lobby) during the mid-day cleaning. Air filters will be utilized to promote ventilation.
 - For class purposes, there will be a section assigned per student for the entire week. This will ensure that only one person is training within that specified area and minimize contact from others.
 - Individual equipment will also be assigned and be used by one person only such as, paddle and/or shield. (Those who have their own equipment, we advise to bring that instead.)
- Use of the open floor (dojang area) will be limited to specific activities only. Dojang floor will be disinfected and mopped after any day the floor is used for activities.
- Campers will abide social distancing rules at all times as much as reasonably possible.
- Masks must be worn at all times as tolerable, especially if social distancing seems less viable.
- All cleaning cycles will be recorded and signed by the performing staff as they are completed to reassure parents and campers that sanitation has been executed.
