We also send our wishes and energy for a speedy recovery to those who are attempting to heal. Many are asking, "What do I do now?" Respectfully, I would universally suggest the following:

STEP ONE: Keep your heart available which will allow your mind to remain open. When ready, consider participating in dialogue with your family, friends, acquaintances, neighbors, or affiliates. Note: This is not an exercise to argue, debate, or lecture, but instead to listen and share about topics of bullying, bias, bigotry, prejudice, racism, and/or discrimination.

<u>The Purpose of Dialogue</u>: **A**. To get to know one another on a more personal level. **B**. To build trust for the individuals or within a group. **C**. To create a safe environment for all participants to be open and honest. **D**. To build mutual understanding and respect among participants. <u>The Four Pillars of Dialogue</u>: 1. Clarity. 2. Fairness. 3. Empathy. 4. Responsibility.

STEP TWO: Locate your local social services organization who is committed to public work and request support or offer to help. As an example, Human Relations Initiative, Inc. has built a distinguished record of 65 years of service to the San Antonio Region through our portfolio of services; <u>https://ucofsa.org/services</u>. More specifically, Community Outreach, Diversity Training (Adult), Social Justice Initiatives, and Programming (Youth).

As it relates to Dialogue Initiatives, our goals are:

- To highlight that Human Relations Initiative, Inc. is a human relations organization for advocacy and social justice through inclusion, understanding, and respect via awareness, education, and dialogue
- To express that Human Relations Initiative, Inc. is a community resource, available in both non-emergency and emergency situations specific to current events; ready, willing, and able to assist in understanding diversity, cultural appreciation, and effective cross-cultural interactions
- To participate in and/or facilitate dialogue initiatives with citizens and local groups, bringing all key leaders together, while creating a safe space to allow for respectful communication.

STEP THREE: Remain committed to ensuring equality is no longer dismissed as a luxury, <u>but instead recognized as a commodity</u>, in hopes for it to be realized!
