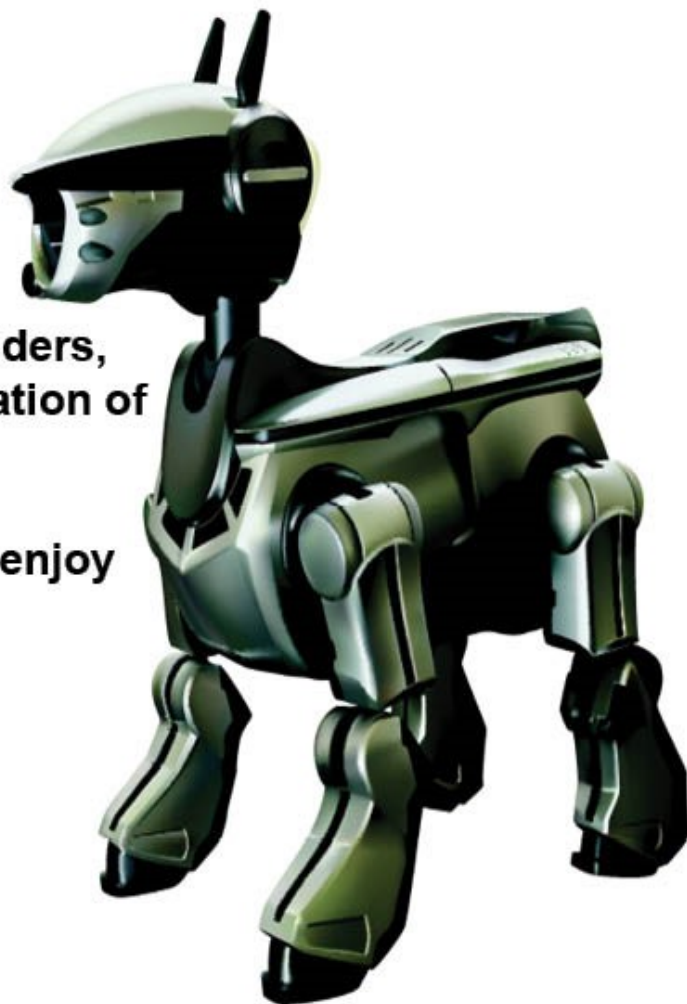

ANNUAL MEETINGS AND REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

Annual Meetings and Reports of Committees:

Full Committee reports are available upon request.

Daniel Haddy, **Agility Committee**, reports that the agility trials are going along at a steady pace, and that we are averaging about 87 to 90 percent full. Some money is made at each trial and funneled back into the club. We made almost \$3000 at our November trial last year. Judges are selected for the next 2 years. Clyde Clossen and Dave Hirsch judged at the May trial, and Christie Bowers and John DeFillippi will judge on Thanksgiving weekend. Daniel thanks the committee for all their hard work and dedication!

Denise Gordon, 2018 **Awards** Chair Report. The awards chair position covers the Versatility and Register of Merit programs as well as the annual awards of Dog of the Year and Member of the Year. There were two major changes: first, the Top Canaan Dog performance awards were discontinued as of December 31st for the reasons outlined in (Denise's) 2017 report. Second was the implementation of the new Versatility awards matrix as of January 1st of this year. The first Versatility Master was awarded to dual champion "Orela" owned by Julie and Dan Haddy. Denise congratulates everyone who earned a title in any organization this past year, and encourages them to keep up the good work!

Denise Gordon, **GAZETTE BREED COLUMN EDITOR REPORT**. Thank you to Heidi Rosin, guest columnist for the December issue, who wrote insightfully on the differences of rehoming Canaan adults versus starting life with a puppy. Denise encourages members to submit ideas for the column, or to write a column themselves!! Please contact Denise at desertstarcanaans@yahoo.com to find a very grateful editor!

Joan Capaiu Greene & Norma Bennett Woolf submitted their **Legislative** report for March 2019. The AKC, National Animal Interest Alliance and a handful of legislators had worked hard to get a mandate for a multi-agency report on dog transportation to assess the impact of imported dogs on public health. Also on the upside were more state laws to give paramedics the authority to treat animal victims after they treat human victims at a fire or accident, and more bills to deal with service dog fraud. On the down side were attempts to

regulate home hobby breeds and pet stores. By limiting access to public parks more attempts to restrict hunting and other dog sports would be made. More bills softening the due process rights of owners by allowing authorities to seize dogs based on suspicion rather than reasonable or probable cause.

Ways and Means Committee Report - Chair Annette Israel reported that the committee had several items for sale at the 2018 specialty. T-shirts, tote bags and Canaan etched cutting boards sold out. April Gray and Annette are working on items for the future. Also a site where orders for Canaan related items is now available. They will continue to add new items and designs throughout the year.

2018-2019 **Web Committee** Annual Report from John Relph and Joan Capaiu Greene, co-chairs. In addition to information concerning the National Specialty, updates to programs, breeder information, and the like are published on the web site as quickly as possible. John has improved the reliability and speed of the web site by making it easier to find the Breeder Referral (how to find a puppy) page and including the ability to read the web site on mobile devices. Visitors are referred from other web sites including Canaan Dog Rescue Network. The total cost per year to operate the web site is \$170 which includes services from DNS, Site hosting, and Domain name registration. John and Joan invite CDCA members with ideas on how to improve the site or provide additional content for the public via the web site to contact them.

Sally J. Armstrong, **Breeder Referral** Chair. Job description: Among many other responsibilities, Sally maintains a file of qualified Breeders, insures that their applications are kept current, and that they meet CDCA qualifications. She identifies those who meet and greet potential owners, and tracks the status of puppies from breeding to whelping. She also keeps a file of older puppies and adult dogs who need placement. Since 1997, Sally has sent out over 1500 information packages to new and aspiring owners. In 2013, the information package was updated by a committee chaired by Carrie Franz. An information package can now be sent by email. There are still requests for hard copies and phone calls. In 2001, 252 packages were sent out. In 2018, 24. a breeder has to meet Club requirements to be on the Breeders List, that is, she must have bred a litter within

the past two years. Otherwise she can join the Meet and Greet program, and, with Board approval, move freely between the two statuses. Cost is \$30 plus \$3.00 s&h. send your request to Sally Armstrong, 2300 Crossover Road, Reno, NV 89510-9354. This organized committee serves the best interest of Canaan Dog fanciers.

2019 Meet & Compete — Meet The Breeds, Westminster Week, New York City. Amanda Pough has been running the booth for many years and writes: "Once again, this Meet The Breeds continues to grow. AKC President Dennis Sprung reports the gate was the largest ever, with attendees telling us at times they had to close the doors. HUGE thanks to the dogs & humans who worked the booth: Ranger & Ian (Lindsey and Nick Nelson, humans), Jez (Dave Pohl), Tux (Travis & Adam Feinberg), Simi (Cathi and Aviva Oskow & Aviva's boyfriend Austin), and Rocket (Keith Marran). Thanks also to Richard Vulliet & Lorna Hastings Menaker for stopping by on Saturday, and to Julie Haddy & Chris Miller for their long distance pre-booth logistical support. This year our booth position was back on the main aisle. This aisle is deliberately wider but still is packed all day long. We were also the FIRST dog booth in our aisle. As a result, we are never at a loss for visitors. Our Booth is designed to bring folks in to our area to interact with the dogs more than "drive by" pats. For the second year we encouraged visitors to explore the booth to find answers to a three question quiz. All who completed the quiz were entered into a drawing to receive a stuffed animal. Appropriately for the breed, our awards this year were a stuffed sheep and stuffed goat. Our winners this year were Violet from Brooklyn, and Oona, from New York City. Sheila Paige took photos which will be shared when available. Sheila is a professional photographer and videographer who donates her time to the breed. Cell phone camera photos and a video are posted on the club Facebook page. Cathi Oskow has been asked to do the write up for the Spring Kib. Going forward, we still have sufficient Club approved printed materials for at least one more year. I have been in contact with CDRN as we have used up their handouts (we do have a sign for them). Those who are currently volunteering have expressed a willingness to continue volunteering as schedules allow. We certainly welcome any and all additional dogs and/or humans. The only "problem" for the event is not one the club can fix. Parking at the Piers was reduced this year due to physical damage to the Pier, and contracted parking

garages were overwhelmed. AKC has since been in contact with volunteers about his issue and will adjust plans in future years. 2019 Meet The Breeds NYC: the crowds were enormous, and the dogs wonderful. We should be incredibly proud of them all.

The Kibitzer newsletter: Christina Miller (interim editor): Discussion needed. Should we go completely digital? New editor? Feedback needed.

Health: Donna Davison expressed concern about the too frequent occurrence of hypothyroidism in Canaans as did Richard Vulliet among others. There are issues with male infertility, litter size of females, and other signs of abnormal behavior which suggest thyroid influence as do other symptoms. Donna will attend the CHF Canine Health Foundation conference in August at Purina Farms. "Seeing as how I have been recovering from double knee replacement since the last specialty, there is not much to report. I am thrilled that there is an opportunity for blood to be submitted to the DNA Repository. Many thanks to those who made the arrangements. I can't say it enough, if we don't have samples there ready to go, we are not going to be included in any research. "As in my previous report, I believe we have some concurs with thyroid. I do plan to gather more information on male infertility at a young age. Our health survey needs to be revised or possibly replaced."

Desert Bred Canaan Dog Registry, Joan Capai Greene: New AKC Rules removed the initial and best plan of the committee. New options involve registering with UKC, FCI or Israeli KC. Dogs could receive titles from those organizations, or CDCA titles (like Herding), but would not be AKC registerable. Three generations later, those offspring will have pedigrees that AKC will accept.

Membership, Amy Preston: Concerns and housekeeping issues discussed at Board Level. Some issues have the potential to be addressed when/if the Constitution & By Laws are update (for example: Junior Memberships, long renewal period).

Judges Education, Christina Miller: Review of presentation made within last year. There will be judges seminar in Houston in July this year sponsored by DJAA. Plans to add more to online resources.

Annette Israel sent the following items to discuss, vote on and present to the membership at the AGM. Board discussed and will pass as appropriate to Committees/Members:

1. The jobs, responsibility, and descriptions of each position need to be updated. Board agrees. Cynthia Dodson will collect.
2. I would like to discuss the idea of going back to a one year membership requirement to become a full member. Annette's motion to do away with associate membership status was unanimously approved. A change in CBL is required to move to electronic voting and for shortening time for associate members to become full voting members. There is no longer a requirement to be the owner of a Canaan dog. (Cynthia moved and Chris seconded). Board referred to C&BL Review Committee.
3. In the Canaan dog information trifold there is incorrect information in respect to our standard vs what the trifold says. Board referred to the Public Education & Publicity Committee for review/correction.

President Mrs. Julie Haddy gave her report, as did CDCA Treasurer, Mrs. Christina Miller.

President Julie reported that the Board has approved the 2020 Specialty for October 16-18, 2020 all-breed shows at Eukanuba Hall, Roberts Centre, Wilmington, Ohio in conjunction with the Clermont County Kennel Club. Denise Gordon will chair.

The 2021 specialty has been approved for Canyon Cluster November 12-15, 2021, in Tucson, AZ. Risa Baumrind will chair.

The Treasurer's report was detailed and showed Income and Expenses for 2018. CDCA's bi-annual sponsorship of two Agility Trials has consistently rewarded the Club with profits to offset losses from annual national specialties.

Recording Secretary's report: the Membership process became an agenda item at the BOD and AGM meetings. The motion to accept the membership applications of Chris and Cindy Oxley, Keith and Cheryl Shank, and David Blake was made, seconded, and approved by the BOD.

2020 NS & DS Specialty judges, Christina Miller & Jimmy Moses, were approved based on the results of the Judges Selection voting by the membership. The BOD tabled discussion of future judges to the AGM.

The Top Dog Program has been retired for lack of participation. A new program of Performance Dogs Recognition is spearheaded by Risa Baumrind to recognize the dogs competing in Obedience, Rally & Agility based on data received from AKC which does not require submission of scores by owners. We hope those participating in these events will enjoy seeing the results.

Meet The Breed events in Orlando & New York were well represented with dogs and club members who were greeted by large & enthusiastic crowds.

The primary income for the club continues to be revenue from the agility trials hosted twice per year in SC. Primary expense continues to be the National Specialty. Whenever possible, the club continues to support charitable causes.

Reports of Committees were reviewed and as appropriate, Board returned comments on committee work or questions or passed those questions to others as appropriate.

Board meeting was adjourned at 9:15pm.

To the Board of Directors of the Canaan Dog Club of America,

Since the last Annual Meeting of the Canaan Dog Club of America (CDCA) in May 2018, held at Purina Farms, Gray Summit, Missouri, there have been three American Kennel Club (AKC) Delegate meetings—the June 2018 and September 2018 meetings held in Newark, New Jersey and the December 2018 meeting held in Orlando, Florida, where I have been honored and privileged to represent the CDCA as your Delegate. I am currently serving my fifth term on the Delegate Bylaws Committee, which reviews and makes recommendations on proposed amendments to the Bylaws. I have also served on the Bylaws Joint Subcommittee (with the Delegate Advocacy and Advancement Committee) on the Future Direction of the Delegate Body, examining the growth and governance of the AKC. The powers of an AKC Delegate include approving Rules governing dog shows and field trials, approving amendments to the AKC Bylaws, approving new member clubs, electing Del-

JUNE 16, 2019: Upon review, the nomination from the floor did not fulfill the requirements required under the Constitution & By-Laws. The Slate as nominated by the Nominating Committee was declared elected.

JUNE 2, 2019: Richard Vuilliet sent a document offering himself as an additional candidate for Vice President on the 2019 CDCA slate of officers and Board members.

MAY 22, 2019: Cynthia Dodson asks calls for votes on the honorary membership application of Melissa Hunt, sponsored by Julie Haddy. The Board approved Melissa's honorary membership.

MAY 21, 2019: Corresponding Secretary Richard Vuilliet forwarded "Thank You for Participating in AKC Meet the Breeds" from Dennis B. Sprung. This was AKC's 10th Annual Meet the Breeds event. MARCH 2, 2019: Denise Gordon asks Board approval for hiring of Marjorie Underwood as the 2020 National Specialty Sweepstakes judge and Nancy Amburgey as the 2020 Designated specialty Sweepstakes judge. The 2020 National specialty will be held on Friday, October 16 as a stand-alone specialty, and the Designated specialty will be held on Saturday, October 17, within the Clermont County Kennel Club all-breed shows at Roberts Centre in Wilmington, Ohio. Approved.

Comments on Canaan Dog Designated Specialty, March 9, 2019 at the Tullahoma Kennel Club of Tennessee Show:

It was a pleasure to judge this nice entry of 24 on the weekend of your National Specialty. Thanks for your hospitality in having me attend and speak at your Club dinner on Saturday. It was fun to see you congratulate each other during the Award presentations. Not every club does this and when we celebrate our shared accomplish-

ments the breed is strengthened.

Judges come to the ring with their ideas about priorities in judging a breed. I watched the large Canaan dog entry at Crufts 2 years ago and have seen the breed at work in Jordan (within the park at Petra). In Herding group breeds function, as far as we can see it in the ring, is essential. I'm looking for the agility and grace that your standard describes as part of the ground covering endurance trot. This includes a short solid athletic topline. Your standard also does a good job describing the desired wedge shape head, unusual low-set but erect ears and the square outline. These are the key features, along with soundness and good temperament that formed my priorities in judging this nice entry.



My Winners Dog (and later BOW) came from the 12-18 class. He was a dog of wonderful size and proportion who was strong and balanced going around. He was good down and back and willing to show his expression and good head. A little loose in the front, I'm confident that maturity will bring that in line.

My Winners bitch and Reserve were from Bred-By, my favorite class. The WB was perhaps the best moving exhibit in the whole entry. Her athleticism and ground covering tireless trot was on display every time she stepped out. She had a typical head and was willing to show it. I would give her a touch more leg, but what was there worked very well. I'm not surprised that she finished her championship in 3 shows this weekend, quite the feat!

The Veteran Bitch (and later Select Bitch) had nice proportion and her head was unmistakably feminine in its good wedge shape. She was sound and athletic in a way that belied her age (8 ½).

A glance down the line when the breed competitors came in showed the skilled hand of your breeders in the consistency of type on display. Three males stood out and were awarded BOB, Select and AOM. The BOB dog combined great square profile, a handsome and masculine wedge shaped head, athletic, sound and balanced gait, and showmanship unusual in this breed. The BOB

dog's strongest competition came from the Bitch who I awarded BOS. She also was wonderfully proportioned, sound and showed great breed type. It was a pleasure to choose between these great examples and the Select Bitch, Select dog and AOM dog. All are a credit to the breed, their breeder and owners.

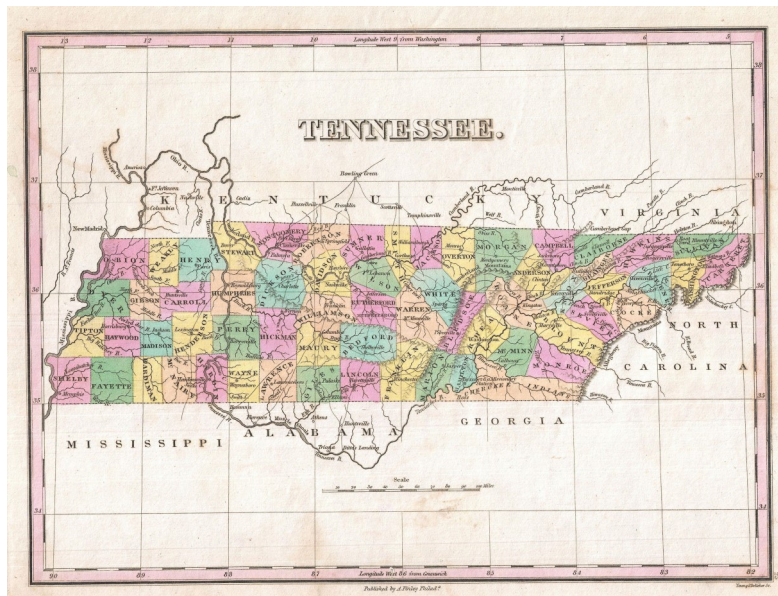

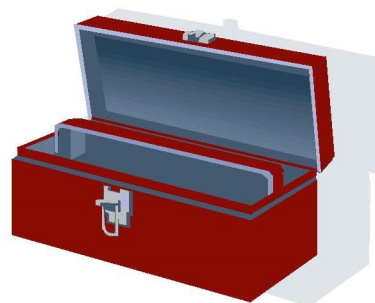

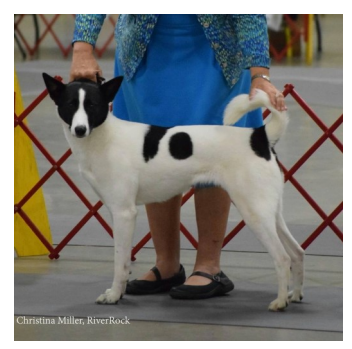
