### PHILADELPHIA BENCHING ~ BOTH DAYS

By order of the Fire Marshal, crates will not be allowed in the benching aisles or ring areas. Space will be provided in the benching section for the cleaning and preparation of dogs for exhibition. Grooming tables in excess of 24" x 36" will not be permitted. Tables must be folded when not in use. The grooming of dogs in areas other than the benching area is not permitted either day. Private Exercise pens MUST have plastic underneath and around the bottom. NO PRIVATE EXERCISE PENS WILL BE PERMITTED BETWEEN 8:00 A.M. & 6:00 P.M. These Regulations will be strictly enforced.

# NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

**EACH DAY IS A BENCHED SHOW** 

All dogs must arrive by 11:00 A.M.

Dogs WILL NOT be excused during benching hours (8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M. Saturday & 8:00 A.M. - 3:00 P.M. Sunday)

Dogs are not permitted to leave the building once they enter each day, i.e. if a breed has completed judging at 9:00 A.M. the dogs are required to go to the benching area for the remainder of the day and be available to meet the public.

A bench audit will be conducted. Once inside the building during show hours, no dog may exit until after 5:00 P.M. on Saturday or 3:00 P.M. on Sunday. Dogs present must be on their assigned benches, except for the necessary periods when they are actually being prepared for showing, are being shown, are in the exercise pen, or are being taken to or from these places. This will be enforced! Violations of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee, which may result in cancellation of the dog's winnings and subject the owner or handler to further action by the American Kennel Club.

### **Building Access:**

The building will be available for exhibitors at 3:00 P.M. on Wednesday.

Exhibitors may enter the building until 10:00 P.M.

The building will be **locked between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. each night.**No one will be allowed access to the building during these hours.

Between 5:00 P.M. and 10:00 P.M. SATURDAY, dogs may be removed for exercising with proper identification. Security guards and Site Control personnel will be on duty. Dog Identification (ID's) with armband numbers will be sent via email to the email addresses provided with entry the week before the show. No paper ID's will be postal mailed. This E-mail ID can be used on Saturday and Sunday for ADMISSION and also for BENCHING RELEASE at the exit each day. You can show this email ID on your phone or mobile device to the security guards for exit. Paper copies of the ID's will also be available at the Superintendents office.

All dogs must enter and exit through Exhibitors' Entrance.



# NOTICE IMPORTANT NOTICE

The Philadelphia style benching concept was conceived by former Kennel Club of Philadelphia President, L. Stewart Cochrane to make the benched show more comfortable, convenient and attractive to all exhibitors and spectators. **NOTE:** There will be **NO separate grooming areas.** All grooming will be done at the assigned benches. There will be **NO private exercise pens in benching area.** Exercise pens will be provided at several locations. There may be some room in Hall E for private exercise pens if needed and must be approved by Show Chair or Site Control. Plastic for the floor shavings and clean up will be the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

- 1. For children's and dogs' safety, NO STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED INTHE BUILDING.
- 2. All dogs entered by an owner/exhibitor or agent/handler can be benched together. If you are an exhibitor/agent and you wish to have all your dogs benched together, you MUST make a request in writing. This request MUST include your name(s), Handler's Number, the AKC registration number, and breeds of those dogs you want benched together. This request MUST be received by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries. A form is included on page 9 of this premium list for your convenience. Multi-breed benching requests must have the same ownership or handler name and number.
- 3. A special index will be included in the Judging Program to help you locate your benching area. The Superintendent will provide name signs on benches and rows for quick identification of benching areas.
- 4. All exhibitors and agents will be permitted to have their grooming equipment only immediately in front of their respective benches. There will be no separate areas for grooming or crates. Stacking of crates on breed benches will not be permitted, except in the case of Toy Breeds. By order of the Fire Marshal, crates will not be permitted in any aisle, at any ring or on any floor space. All crates MUST be on the benching.
- 5. Bench numbers will not be permitted to be changed or altered in any manner.
- 6. All dogs must be benched in accordance with "Notice to all Exhibitors" on page 7. Once a dog is admitted into the show building it cannot leave until the normal release time when benching hours are concluded each day. This will be strictly enforced by the Superintendent and the Event Committee.
- 7. The Superintendent will provide Handlers/Agents in the Multi-Breed sections only with name signs on their benches and rows for quick identification of their benching area. Crate stacking will be required in these rows.
- 8. Electricity for grooming will be provided by The Kennel Club of Philadelphia, Inc. However, only one appliance can be connected to each outlet at one time. Additional appliances on a single circuit will cause an overload. Exhibitors will be charged to reactivate a circuit.

NR1.08100.15000. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years & over.

NR1.08200. Hunting Classes - Class for dogs and class for bitches which have earned a Junior, Senior of Master Hunter Title in an AKC Licensed or Member Test or a JAM or better in a Licensed Field Trial.

### **SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES**

NR1.08900. Sled Dog Classes - Requirements for Sled Dog Classes are listed below and must receive strict adherence. No deviation from the rules allowed.

- 1.Entry must be an AKC or CKC registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, of the AKC Rules regarding Registration and Dog Shows).
- 2....... There will be a class for dogs & a class for bitches.
- 3.To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
- a.) During the previous racing season, each entry must have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of five (5) miles per heat or seventy (70) miles of competition. All races must be on snow with sleds & under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31.
- b.) Entries have completed five (5) years in competition where the above requirements have been met shall be automatically qualified for Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the five (5) years of proof of competition records are sent in.
- c.) Entries who have been awarded a SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 4. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged.

All dogs and bitches entering the above classes must be intact.

# NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES SATURDAY & SUNDAY - SIBERIAN HUSKIES

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Stud Dog only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety Competition by virtue of having won these classes.

NR2.09300. Brace Class - Two dogs of the same breed and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". In making entries for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1," "Brace No. 2," etc. Dogs entered in Brace Only may be neutered or spayed.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. - 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
