PNW-SETAC ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

PLEASE follow instructions carefully!

Abstracts, excluding author and title lines, should be <u>no more than 300 words</u>. <u>Longer abstracts will</u> be returned to the author for editing.

The abstract should be in the format shown, below, following these instructions:

- Type the title of the abstract in bold and in Title case. Center the title on the page.
- List authors with the last name first, then the first and middle initials.
- In the case of 2 or more authors, place an asterisk *after the name of the person <u>presenting</u> the paper/poster.
- In cases of authors from different institutions, use a superscripted number at the end of each author's name and the corresponding number in front of their institution.
- Include the name of the institution, the city and state, but <u>not</u> the department affiliation or street address.
- Use **Time New Roman** font, **size 11**, one-inch left and right margins, **single spaced**, fully **justified** to right and left margins, species names should be in italics.
- Do not indent any part of the body of the abstract text. <u>Use "returns" for spacing</u>. The text should be a single paragraph.

The following information should be included after the abstract:

- 1. Presenting author and affiliation, Contact Author (we suggest that this be the presenting author)
- 2. Institution, complete mailing address, phone number, FAX number, and your E-mail address
- 3. Your preference for oral or poster presentation
- 4. <u>Students</u>: please indicate your degree program, e.g., M.S., B.S., PhD <u>AND</u> university/college
- 5. Is this abstract for proposing a **Short Course?** _____ A **Special Session?**____
