

Home Education Parent Responsibility Policy

TEACH exists as a ****resource for home education families****. TEACH provides classes, instructors, curriculum resources, activities, guidance, and educational opportunities to support parents in their home education journey.

****TEACH is not the student's school and does not assume responsibility for the student's overall education, academic progress, course completion, grades, credits, graduation requirements, college readiness, or educational success.****

Under a home education model, the ****parent or legal guardian remains 100% responsible for the student's education and learning path.****

This includes responsibility for:

- Selecting appropriate courses, curriculum, and educational materials.
- Determining the student's academic level and appropriate placement.
- Monitoring the student's progress throughout the year.
- Ensuring assignments and coursework are completed.
- Evaluating student learning and determining mastery.
- Providing additional instruction, tutoring, or support when needed.
- Maintaining educational records, portfolios, grades, transcripts, and other required documentation.
- Ensuring the student meets any applicable state home education requirements.
- Determining credits earned and ensuring graduation requirements are met.
- Making decisions regarding testing, dual enrollment, college admissions, scholarships, NCAA eligibility, or other postsecondary goals.
- Communicating with instructors when questions or concerns arise.

Participation in a TEACH class or program does not guarantee that a student will master the material, earn a particular grade, receive credit, meet graduation requirements, qualify for college admission, or achieve any particular academic outcome.

TEACH instructors provide instruction and educational support within the scope of their individual classes; however, ****the parent remains the primary educator and is responsible for determining whether the instruction, curriculum, pace, assignments, and student performance are appropriate for their child.****

Parents should regularly review their student's work, progress, attendance, assignments, and educational plan. Concerns regarding a student's learning, academic performance, or educational path should be addressed by the parent promptly.
