

TEACH Belief Statement & Biblical Worldview

****TEACH welcomes families and students of all backgrounds and beliefs.**** We are a biblically based organization committed to maintaining biblical values, standards, and truth in our teaching, activities, and community life.

Families are not required to personally share every belief outlined below to participate. However, ****all families and students must acknowledge that TEACH operates from a biblical worldview and agree to respect this foundation while on campus and participating in TEACH classes, activities, and events.**** This expectation also applies to guests.

Our Beliefs

****1. The Bible****

We believe the Bible is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God. It is the final authority in all matters of faith, truth, and conduct.

****2. God****

We believe in one God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—eternal in being, holy, loving, and sovereign.

****3. Jesus Christ****

We believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God, born of a virgin, sinless, crucified for our sins, risen from the dead, and returning again in glory.

****4. The Holy Spirit****

We believe the Holy Spirit is fully God, convicting the world of sin and empowering believers for holy living and service.

****5. Salvation****

We believe all people have sinned and need salvation through Jesus Christ alone, by grace through faith, resulting in a transformed life.

****6. Humanity & the Image of God****

We believe all people are created in the image of God—male and female—with equal value, dignity, and purpose according to His design.

****7. Marriage & Family****

We believe marriage is a sacred covenant created by God between one man and one woman and forms the foundation of the family.

****8. The Sanctity of Life****

We believe every human life, from conception to natural death, is sacred and created by God, deserving protection and care.

****9. The Return of Christ & Eternity****

We believe in the personal return of Jesus Christ and the resurrection of all people—the saved to eternal life and the lost to eternal separation from God.

****10. Christian Education & Discipleship****

We believe education is a form of discipleship that shapes the heart and mind. True learning begins with the fear of the Lord and integrates biblical truth into all areas of study and life.

Respect Within Our Community

Students and families understand that biblical teaching, prayer, Scripture, and discussion of Christian beliefs may be included in TEACH classes and activities.

Everyone is expected to demonstrate respect through their words, actions, and interactions. Respectful questions and discussions are welcome. Mocking, harassment, or disruption directed toward TEACH's beliefs or toward individuals because of their beliefs is not acceptable.

Families are responsible for helping their children and guests understand these expectations. Differences in personal belief do not excuse disrespectful behavior, and every person is to be treated with dignity and care.
