

TEACH Dress Code

Students are welcome to dress comfortably while maintaining a ****conservative, non-revealing appearance**** appropriate for our learning community.

Clothing Expectations

- Shirts must fully cover the stomach, back, and chest, including during normal movement.
- ****Tank tops are allowed****, provided they meet the same coverage requirements.
- Clothing must provide appropriate coverage when sitting, bending, or participating in activities.
- Clothing must not be revealing or see-through, and undergarments must remain covered.

Shoes

****Shoes are optional—it's just a homeschool thing!**** Shoes may be required for specific classes or activities for safety. Students should bring shoes so they are available when needed.

Family Responsibility

Parents and students are responsible for ensuring clothing meets these expectations before arriving on campus. If an outfit does not meet the dress code, the student will be asked to change or add appropriate coverage. A parent may be contacted to bring a change of clothing if needed.
