I am excited for the start of class in just a few weeks! Please read this email for important information about this class.

Materials:

Students need to have a small three ring binder to keep their scripts in. They should have a highlighter to highlight their lines and pencil and paper to take notes.

They will make an account on our online classroom system, called Mellow Yellow Education. I will have a flyer for them the first day of class on how to set up their account. This platform allows them to access the scripts, read any announcements/updates I have, and complete their homework.

Overview of the Class:

From August-November, we will build up their acting skills. We will go through the audition process of filming themselves doing the script and submitting it to me, as well as in person auditions. They will practice memorizing lines, developing their character, and implementing feedback. We also start to develop the idea for our film in the spring.

From January-May, we will be making our short film. You can watch the films from the past 2 years here!
