The Learn-by-Doing curriculum offers 1 bundle of 3-spiral curriculum allowing students to visit newly learned skills many times to achieve mastery. Upon completion of the Level 1 curriculum your student is able to take the MOS (Microsoft Office Specialist) Associate Certification Exam. This certification, recognized by Certiport, assesses proficiency in Microsoft 365 applications in a project-based environment.

As you prepare for the upcoming year, please gather the following supplies before our Open House:

## Course Needs:

Students are required to bring the following items:

- A laptop with Microsoft Office 365 Desktop installed and fully operational \*BEFORE the first day of class.
- Each student must have a Gmail account or another form of email account. <u>Please ensure the</u> password is written down and readily accessible for your student.
- A link to TYPING.COM will be provided to each student once the class is in session.
- Additionally, please purchase 1 bundle of Learn-By-Doing (Word, Excel, & PowerPoint) from <u>The HomeSchool Hive.</u>

During home study days, parents are encouraged to actively support their child's learning. Progress can be monitored through class participation, lesson quizzes, and project completion. Parents are urged to thoroughly review all assigned work with their students. Assignments will be provided; however, one outstanding feature of the Learn-By-Doing series is its self-paced nature for students. While many students may have some experience with Microsoft applications, we will begin everyone at the same starting point. Students can then progress at their own pace and complete tasks based on their understanding.

I will assess assignments and provide feedback and grades when indicated. Please note, in accordance with the Florida homeschool statute, while I assign grades, the ultimate responsibility for your child's education lies with you, the parent(s). My role is solely to facilitate learning, as outlined in our T.E.A.C.H. handbook.
