IMPORTANT ALLERGY INFORMATION:

- I am ALLERGIC TO LATEX (balloons, latex gloves, or even rubber bands are very unsafe for me). I do have an Epi-pen on hand, just in case.

- As indicated in the information section for this class, Woodworking & Crafting is for students who are in 3rd-6th grade. No lower grades will be accepted.

FAQs:

- How does Mellow Yellow Education (MYE) work?
 - MYE registration information will be sent to you by TEACH prior to Open House.

 - Even if you have had an account with MYE before this school year, ALL students must create new accounts. Old accounts will NOT work.
