I am so excited to meet you and facilitate your reading and comprehension of literature through great books. Please join me at Open House any time from 10-1 at Oakwood Community Church on Wednesday, July 31 so we can meet and I can answer any questions you may have.

In this course, we will use mentor texts, picture books, group activities, and hands-on activities to learn how to construct a cohesive sentence, then expand to paragraphs in a writer's workshop format. Narrative, Opinion, Persuasive, Compare and Contrast, and Nonfiction writing styles will be addressed. We will also explore the link between reading and writing.

Grades will not be assigned but feedback will be given during one-on-one peer and teacher conferencing sessions. Students may enhance writing on home school days, if desired but not required.
