

Option 1: Utilize your own or an organization's syllabus

Suitable for those who

- are connected to an organization but seek additional qualifications via the pathways offered.
- seek to develop their own syllabus or want to be independent.
- have created their own system, or developed a new style, or art form.

Requirements

- Provide a copy of the chosen Syllabus in English (a work in progress is acceptable if developing your own).
- Use of terminology in languages other than English is also acceptable. The Syllabus outline should clearly indicate levels of progression through the ranks from lowest to highest including any special requirements or hurdles along the way.
- Video presentation*
- Technical Work as it applies to various traditional specialist martial arts, martial arts sports, self-defence, and/or eclectic forms.
- Updated Martial Arts CV plus verifiable ID (as it applies to one's country e.g. ID Card etc)
- Supporting documentation – certified copies of documents relating to martial arts, coaching, business, health, child safety, etc.
- Any other requirements

Notes:

A certified translation is required for all documents in languages other than English.

All certifications and local licensing / legal compliance requirements for First Aid, Security, Insurance, Martial Arts Sports et al, need to always be current to be valid if working as a professional martial arts practitioner.

*Video presentations are to be uploaded to a private YouTube channel with a link provided for access. Candidates may also submit a public YouTube presentation or set of presentations with link(s) for viewing. Videos may also be edited, allowing for rest breaks between demonstrations of each aspect of the requirements.

All videos should clearly show the candidate presenting the practical requirements.
