

Scrappy Nine Patch Pillow

Materials Needed for 1 pillow:

- (18) 5" x 5" squares
- Pillow Stuffing

1	2	3
4	5	6
7	8	9

Directions:

1. Square 18 blocks to 5" x 5" squares.

2. Lay out nine 5" x 5" squares with 3 blocks across and 3 rows down.
See diagram above.

3. Sew 3 blocks together in rows.

Sew 1, 2, and 3 together to make row 1.



Sew 4, 5, and 6 together to make row 2.



Sew 7, 8, and 9 together to make row 3.



4. Sew the 3 rows together.

Sew row 1 to row 2.

Sew row 2 to row 3.

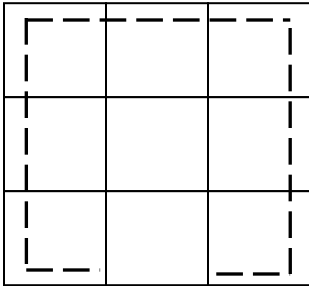
	Row 1

Press all rows down. ↓

5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a pillow back.

6. Finishing:

With right sides together sew around the outside, leaving block 8 open for turning the pillow inside out.



Carefully clip the corners, turn the pillow right side out, and push the corners out gently. Stuff your pillow with stuffing. Turn the open edge under and sew the pillow closed near the edge by hand or on the sewing machine.
