A Day in the Life of an AA

**THIS ISSUE OF THE NEWSLETTER WILL HIGHLIGHT THE
ROLE OF ANESTHESIA ASSISTANTS**

- Curious what a day in the life of an Anesthesia Assistant looks like? We were fortunate enough to speak with Candi Thompson this month, Senior Anesthesia Assistant in Saskatoon. 'AAs arrive early and set up the OR by checking and calibrating anesthesia machines, monitors and emergency equipment. Prepare medications, airway devices, IV supplies and other airway equipment. Assist in various acute surgeries ie Heart Surgery, Awake Intubations, and traumas. AAs help place IVs, Artlines and assist with the induction of anesthesia. AAs provide intraoperative monitoring, continuously monitor and adjust anesthetic gases, medications and ventilator settings. AAs are responsible for on going setups for ORs throughout the day. Several out of OR procedures where an anesthetic is provided, the anesthesia team consists of an AA and an anesthesiologist. AAs provide an expert set of hands that speak the same language as anesthesia. The on call AA will stay late in the ORs to assist with any on going emergent cases.'
- 'You can find AA's in a number of places around the hospital including AAs work in operating rooms, Children's hospital, post anesthetic areas, endoscopy suites, MRI, CT suites, Cath Labs, EP Labs, Neurovascular Suite, Radiation Therapy, and Obstetric Areas.'
