R = Right, L = Left, "GUIDE LEFT" = look left toward center

if 3, **CENTER swimmer** 

(RED sequins & gauntlets/gloves)

INTRO TALKING

STAND in 1 line (abreast) facing R side

in center do as others

INTRO MUSIC

tap outstretched hands (R in back)

THEME 1

16 Front Crawl → DEEP

**DROP FEET** on 14 as prep for 180° turn

16 Front Crawl → SHALLOW

**DROP FEET** on 14 as prep for 180° turn

THEME 2

8 **SALUTE** Front Crawl → DEEP

swishing cross-body SALUTE strokes - LOOKing to cross-side

3 1/2 or 4 full circle-swishing SALUTE [those on Left 3 ½, those on R 4]

w/last salute ½ or full to end up in pivot line

LEGS up into **PIVOT LINE** (to go clockwise, head 1st)

arms outstretched (whole kicking section)

WAIT IN PIVOT LINE

THEME 3

16 counts KICKING - Guide Left (look to center)

(pivot 180°)

16 counts - 8 BEND KNEES (R then Left) – Guide Left (look to center) (continue to pivot 180°)

turn WITH others

turn WITH others

WAIT & THEN TUB

THEME 4

16 counts - 8 TUB 45° LIFTS (R, L) NO kicking – Guide Left (look to center) (continue pivot 180°)

REVERSE

16 counts – NO PIVOTing

8 INDIVIDUAL turning TUB 45° LIFTS (R,L) INDIVIDUAL TURNS

(each TURN 3/4 Clockwise till facing IN)

**ENDING** facing IN

last Left Tub Lift is #8

Lift BOTH feet as #9, SINK

RISE with R arm in front facing center

R arm swish TURN to face AUDIENCE, SALUTE

Drop arm, swish as needed & EXIT

raise both arms straight up & SINK NOT to either

Turn, Salute audience
