## Bible Bowl Lesson 8 Summary of Lessons 1 to 7 and Questions for Lesson 8 BRIEF REVIEW OF "PREPARATION FOR THE END TIME"

- a. **Introduction**: "Christ and the End of Days" How should we prepare? "As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him". (Col. 2:6); "For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified." (1 Cor. 2:2).
- b. **Lesson 1**: "The Cosmic Controversy" "And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus [a]Christ." Rev. 12:17
- c. **Lesson 2**: "Daniel and the End Time" "The king answered Daniel, and said, "Truly <sup>(A)</sup>your God *is* the God of <sup>(B)</sup>gods, the Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, since you could reveal this secret." Daniel 2:47
- d. **Lesson 3**: "Jesus and the Book of Revelation" "To him who overcomes (A)I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne." Rev. 3:21.
- e. **Lesson 4**: "Salvation and the End Time" "In this is love, <sup>(A)</sup>not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son <sup>(B)</sup>to be the propitiation for our sins." 1 John 4:10
- f. **Lesson 5**: "Christ in the Heavenly Sanctuary" "Therefore God also <sup>(B)</sup>has highly exalted Him and <sup>(C)</sup>given Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> <sup>(D)</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth," Philippians 2:9,10.
- g. **Lesson 6**: "The 'Change' of the Law" "He shall speak *pompous* words against the Most High, Shall <sup>(B)</sup> persecute <sup>[a]</sup> the saints of the Most High, And shall <sup>(C)</sup> intend to change times and law. Then <sup>(D)</sup> the saints shall be given into his hand <sup>(E)</sup> For a time and times and half a time." Daniel 7:25
- h. **Lesson 7**: "Matthew 24 and 25" "False christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, (B) if possible, even the elect." Matthew 24:24

## **Lesson 8**: "Worship the Creator"

- 1. (10 points) "Then I saw another angel <sup>(M)</sup>flying in the midst of heaven, <sup>(N)</sup>having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—<sup>(O)</sup>to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—<sup>7</sup> saying with a loud voice, <sup>(P)</sup> "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; <sup>(O)</sup> and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water." Rev. 14:6, 7.
  - a. Who is the angel? See Revelation 10:11
  - b. What is the "everlasting gospel?" See 1Corinthians 15:1-4
  - c. How do we "fear" God?
  - d. How do we "give glory" to Him?
- 2. (10 points) Peter states: "For this reason (A)I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, (B)though you know and are established in the present truth." 2 Peter 1:12. (See vv. 1-10 also).
  - a. What is the "Present Truth?"
  - b. Does the Seventh-day Adventist Church have the "Present Truth?"
  - c. How are we individually affected and involved in the "Present Truth?"
- 3. (10 points) One of the most profound and moving witness to Jesus was given by the person related in Luke 23:32-43. (Monday's section. See also The Desire of Ages, pp. 750-751)
  - a. Name the individual
  - b. How did he address Jesus?
  - c. What does Jesus' reply to him reveal about Jesus?
- 4. (3 points) 1 Corinthians 6:11 reminds the faithful followers of Jesus of the truth as it relates to their own judgment. The key words are: "And such were (A) some of you. (B) But you were \_\_\_\_\_\_, but you were \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God."
- 5. (10 points) A memorable vision of the final judgment as it pertains to God's people is portrayed in Zechariah 3:1-5. This would be the reality that we could see if the veil that separates the visible from the invisible world could be lifted. Could you name the important personalities mentioned in this passage?
