

BIBLE BOWL LESSON 8, “WORSHIP THE CREATOR” – ANSWERS

1. a. The “angel” refers to the messenger; here it refers to the Remnant who are asked to carry the good news to all the world.

b. The “everlasting gospel” as defined by Paul is stated in 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 “Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, ²by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain.

³For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures.”

c. We “fear” God by being awed into reverence by His love, holiness, and majesty like Isaiah did, as John did, as Manoah did.

d. We give “glory” to Him through our lives that reflect His character, by having His mind.

2. a. “The Present Truth” may be rephrased as “The Truth that is Present;” ie., visible, in front of us; it is NOT a creed, not a belief; it is not in a book, even if it is the Bible. Even special light concerning the Sabbath and the Sanctuary has to be more than a doctrine; it needs to change us into His image so we reflect its transforming effect in our lives; it should be written in our hearts (the New Covenant Heb. 10:16); our lives should be the “epistle.” ([2 Corinthians 3:2](#) “You are our **epistle** written in our hearts, known and read by all men;”).

b. In theory certainly, but it needs to be translated into a lifestyle for it to be “living Truth.”

c. We need to realize the soon-ness of His coming and be faithful to represent Him to the lost world.
