- <u>1-F</u> (<u>Forgive</u>) <u>Matthew 6:12</u> "... forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors"
- **2-F** Matthew 6:15 "but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses."
- 3-F Matthew 18:21-35 "Then Peter came up and said to him, "Lord, how often will my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? As many as seven times...?"
- **4-F** Colossians 3:13 "bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive."
- <u>5-F Luke 23:34</u> "And Jesus said, 'Father, **forgive** them, for they know not what they do." And they cast lots to divide his garments."
- <u>6-F</u> <u>Luke 7:47</u> "Therefore I tell you, her sins, which are many, are **forgive**n—for she loved much. But he who is **forgive**n little, loves little."
- 7-F <u>Luke 5:21</u> "And the scribes and the Pharisees began to question, saying, 'Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can **forgive** sins but God alone?'" (End-Forgive)
