DORIKOS (White)

£9 £12 £35

11.5% vol, Mountainous Roditis/Malagousia

This wine comes from the varieties malagousia (white variety, gentle) and mountainous Roditis, (a rare branch of Roditis which has a strong ruby color) this one has the ability to age due to the technique that is vinified, resulting in being richer in organic ingredients and having a brighter color.

DORIKOS (Rose)

11.5% Vol, Mountainous Roditis/Kosmas/ Malagousia

The combination of these varieties is harmonious and gives richness to the wine. Due to the technique that is vinified, it is richer in body and organic ingredients.

DORIKOS (Red)

£10 £13 £37

12.5% Vol, Kosmas Variety

It comes from the rare and unique grape variety of "Kosmas" and has, depending on the year, an intense and vivid red color. It is traditionally vinified in open oak tanks with the use of fir branches and river stones at the top, to protect the grape pulp from oxidation. This practice naturally secretes a small amount of fir resin into the must. The fir resin will add antiseptic protection, texture and some taste to the wine, giving it a unique seal.

KOKKINELY (Red)

£9 £12 £35

12.5% Vol, Kosmas Variety

This year, our winery has released a new light red (reddish) wine from the unique and rare Greek grape variety 'Kosmas', made using the exact same old traditional winemaking method used for our other wines. This wine is made with grapes harvested in 2022 and with only 5 days contact with the stems.
