OUR STORY of the Vos family in America begins in 1863 when Peter Joannes (John) VOS (1808-1876) and his wife, Anna Gertrudis MOORS (1819-1895), with their children, left their home village of Echt, Limburg, Holland, and sailed from Antwerp, on April 22, 1863, aboard the steamer *GERMANIA*, to New York Harbor, with the "declared" destination as St. Paul, Minnesota. Ship records confirm their arrival in New York on May 1, 1863, after a sea journey of 10 days.

In 1864, Johannes Beckers (1820-1898) & Anna Catherine Van Ophoven (1820-1904) set out with 5 children for their journey to America. Scroll down for their story.

The VOS and the BECKERS families come from the Echt, Montfort, Maasbracht areas of Limburg, Netherlands. This area is located between Dusseldorf, Germany and Brussels, Belgium. MAP: https://goo.gl/maps/ehTWEqnhexJ2

The Vos family arrived in Dahlgren Township, Carver County, MN. in 1864 at which point they settled on a 160 acre homestead. There are several different locations associated with this area that pertain to the Vos family. It is somewhat confusing because while they didn't live in a town, they were identified with Chaska because it was the closest town to them. Actually they lived in Dahlgren Township. Other nearby communities that played a part in their history are Waconia, Cologne, and Benton.

SCHMID NOTE: The VOS homestead was 12 miles south of the JOSEPH SCHMID Farmstead on the south shore of Lake Minnetonka.

PETER JOANNES's youngest child, son Reinhard VOS, married Joseph SCHMID's daughter, Magdalena SCHMID

PETER JOANNES's Granddaughter, Gertrude VOS (daughter of his elder son Antonius "Anton" VOS), married Joseph SCHMID'S son, Frank SCHMID. both of these young couples left Carver County for Stearns County, where they homesteaded and raised their families, as did their VOS sister, Agnes.

Three of the VOS siblings, **Anton, Agnes, and Reinhard** moved to **Stearns County**, which is about 80 miles northwest of Minneapolis. Names associated with this area are, **Holding Township, Krain Township and Holdingford**. Also the towns of Avon, Albany, Melrose and Freeport are mentioned in the VOS history, all located in Stearns County,

John VOS (**Peter Joannes**) **Obituary**, December 14, 1876 edition of the "Weekly Valley Herald" of Chaska: "John Voss, one of the old settlers of Dahlgren, died very suddenly on Monday last, having been sick only a few days. He was 68 years of age. He was buried in Cologne." (Correction Note: he was actually buried in Chaska)






