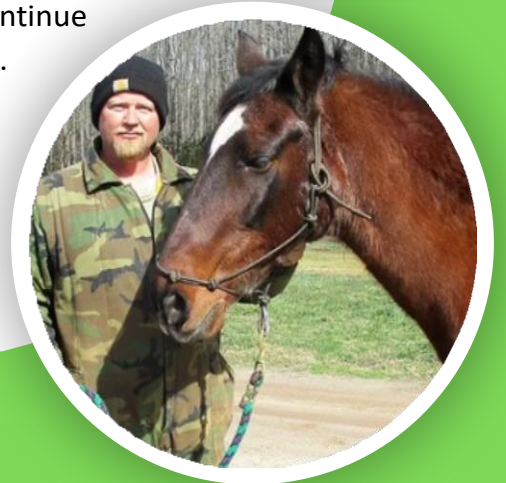


EAGLE SCOUT SERVICE PROJECT
