YUM YUM!



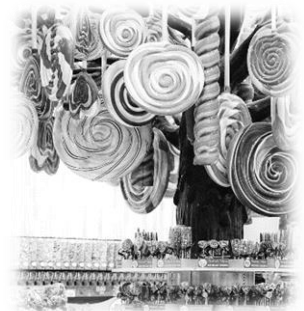
We all surely like lollipops! It is fun to slurp it until it becomes tiny then crunch and eat. Yummy!



Did you know cavemen enjoyed this sweet treat thousands of years ago? They accidentally made lollipops by collecting honey from beehives with a stick. They did not want to waste the sweet nectar, so they licked the stick.



Ancient Chinese, Arabs, and Egyptians mixed fruit and nut in honey and put sticks into the mixture so that it was easier to eat.



In the 17th Century, as sugar became more available in Europe, the English enjoyed boiled sugar candy treats and put sticks into them to make them easier to eat, too.

The modern day lollipop was invented in 1908 by a man called George Smith. He observed a chocolate company who was making chocolates and caramels on sticks. So used this technique to his own, hard candy business.



The world's largest lollipop was more than 15 feet tall including stick, about as tall a giraffe. It was cherry flavor. Today we use machines to make lollipops and now up to 5,900 lollipops are made per minute.

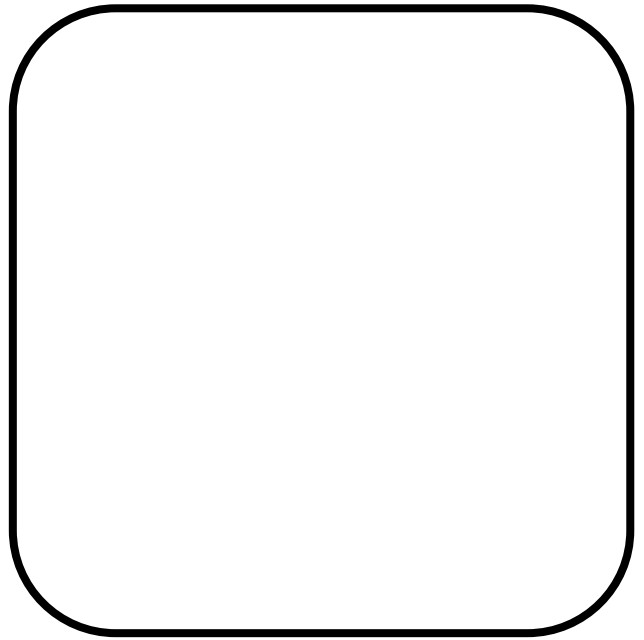

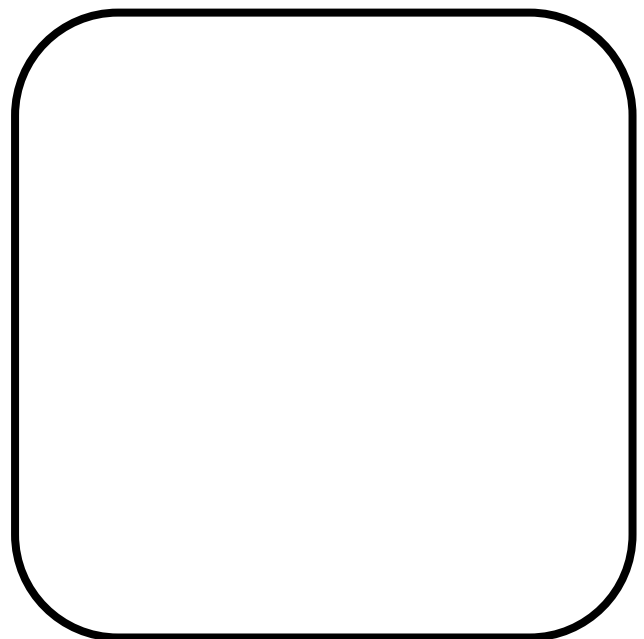
