A yes / no question is:

is a question that has a 'Yes' or 'No' answer.



it must include one of these verbs: BE, DO, HAVE, or a Modal verb.

Making Yes / No Questions

with the BE Verb (am/are/is/was/were)

For example,

sentence word order:

He is tall.

question word order:

Is he tall?

We were late.

Were we late?





Making Yes / No Questions without the BE verb or an Auxiliary/Modal Verb

(Use Do!)

For example,

sentence word order:

I have a problem.

(Main verb no helping verb)

question word order:

Do you have a problem?

Making Yes / No Questions

with Auxiliary / Modal Verbs

These are short words that 'help' the main verb create tense.

(ex: can, must, should, might, may)

For example,

sentence word order: He will come.

question word order:

Will he come?

Sometimes, a sentence can have 2 helping verbs.

(HelpingVerb1 + Subject + HelpingVerb2+ Main Verb)

sentence word order: question word order:

John has been fired. Has John been fired?



Don't forget

Remember the difference between a main verb and a helping verb because verbs like 'do/have/will' can be a main verb and an auxiliary verb.

She has a job. (present simple)

→ Does she have a job?

She has had a job. (present perfect)

→ Has she had a job?
