CO-OPERATIVE SECTION

Entry Fee £5.00

20 points awarded for each co-operative entered

Please note: This will be judged by the public

Class 1 Co-operative: To the Theme

A minimum of five items from Art, Confectionery, Cookery, Craft, Papercraft, Preserves and Fresh Flowers in any combination. To be staged in a space with external measurements no larger than **62cm deep x 107cm high x 92cm** wide by strictly no more than **TWO** members to set up **at the Hall**.

Accessories allowed. Rigid backs and sides are to be provided by the Exhibitor.

NOTE FOR CO-OPERATIVES

Please note that items for exhibits do not need to appear elsewhere in the Schedule. You may choose any suitable items from Art, Confectionery, Cookery, Craft, Papercraft, Preserves and Fresh Flowers to interpret the theme for this Class.

INDIVIDUAL SECTION

FEE: 50p per item

10 points for 1st

8 points for 2nd

6 points for 3rd

4 points for Highly Commended

One point will be awarded for each entry **brought.**

CRAFT

All items to have been made in the last 12 months, be unused and to be the bona fide work of the exhibitor. All items are to have an entry label attached using a thread no longer than 25cm.

- Class 2 A Crocheted Character, to the theme
- Class 3 A Machine Sewn Canvas Beach Bag with inside zipped pocket and outside flap
- Class 4 A Fish worked in Blackwork, not to exceed 20cmx30cm, framed, ready to hang
- Class 5 A Cushion Cover using Hand Embroidery, to fit a 40cm pad. Include a pad
- Class 6 A Bookmark in Torchon Lacework
- Class 7 A Fabric Collage Electronic Tablet Cover, to the theme
- Class 8 A Needle Felted Character, to the theme
- Class 9 A Beaded Bracelet, in the colours of the theme
- Class 10 A Knitted Pirate
- Class 11 An Item of Sugarcraft, to the theme

PAPERCRAFT

Class 13 Cards may have a greeting on the outside. NO ENVELOPE. The card to be judged on the outside only; entry label for Class 13 to be attached with shirring elastic down spine of card. NB Classes 12 and 13 are to the theme.

Class 12 A Shadow Box

Class 13 A Pop-up Birthday Card

CREATIVE WRITING

Entries may be submitted for Classes 14, 15 and 16. All classes may be typed or handwritten.

Class 14 A 2 Act Play, not exceeding 800 words.

Class 15 A Short Story: 'Shipwreck', not exceeding 500 words.

Class 16 An Illustrated Poem entitled 'The Sea', to fit one side of A4 paper.

ART

Classes 17 and 18 must not exceed 46cm x 46cm, including frame. THESE 2 CLASSES MUST BE FRAMED AND STRUNG READY TO BE DISPLAYED. [No clip frames]

Both Classes to have been completed in the last year.

Class 17 A Coastal Landscape using Watercolours

Class 18 A Pencil Drawing

FLORAL ART

All exhibits MUST be brought to the Show FULLY ASSEMBLED

- Class 19 A Table Arrangement incorporating Seashells, using natural materials, no larger than 40cm long x 30cm deep x 20cm high
- Class 20 A Wedding Corsage for a Wrist or a Clutch Bag

CHILDREN'S SECTION - [Children connected with members]

Please state **AGE AND NAME** when entering. Please also give name of member.

AGE 3-4

- Class 21 A Collage using Cut and Paste, on card, to the theme

AGE 5-7

- Class 22 A Picture, on card, made from Shells

AGE 8-11

- Class 23 A Sea Creature made from household recycling materials

AGE 12-15

- Class 24 Three Home-made Bath Bombs

- Class 25 **Betty Sanderson Memorial Trophy (see page 6)**

- Class 26 **Chairman's Challenge Display**

Notes and Rules

- Entrance Fees: Class 1: £5, other classes: 50p, Betty Sanderson £2.00 for 5 entries
- **A maximum of one entry per member per class (2-24) is allowed. All entries to have been made within the previous 12 months and be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.**

Classes 2-10,12-18,21-25 to be delivered to the WI Office, Leyland for judging on **September 6th** between **9.30am and 12.30pm**.

Class 1 (Co-operatives), Class 11 (Sugarcraft), Classes 19 and 20 (Floral Art) and the Betty Sanderson Exhibits to be delivered to **Chorley** on **September 14th** between **8am and 9.30am**.

Entry labels must be attached to exhibits with a thread up to 25cm long unless otherwise stated.

All exhibits must be unpacked before being handed in for judging. Packaging to be removed and taken home.

No exhibit may be removed before 4pm on Saturday September 14th 2024

- LFWI cannot be responsible for any items on display and would suggest that any valuable items be adequately insured by the exhibitor.
