

Leading to Level 2 Food Hygiene and Safety for Catering Certificate

Date: Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2024

**Time:** 10am-12.30pm

Venue: LFWI Office, Croston House, Leyland, PR26 6TU

**Cost:** This Course is **free**, but you will need to pass the certificate online.

The certificate cost is £20 using <a href="https://www.highspeedtraining.co.uk/foodhygiene">www.highspeedtraining.co.uk/foodhygiene</a> There are other providers – the choice of which one you use is up to you.

This course is designed to teach you the content of the Food Hygiene and Safety certificate for you to then go online to sit the exam, either at the office or to go home and do it in your own time.

If you wish to complete the exam on the same day, bring your laptop and some earphones and log on at the office to take the exam. You will need to pay for the exam online. Certificates can be printed immediately or be sent to your home address by the training company.

If your WI provides home made cakes for meetings or caters for events for your own members or the public, you are advised to have at least one member who holds this certificate so that they can then pass on advice to others. It is important that your WI feels confident that food is produced in hygienic and safe conditions.

We recommend your WI pays for one member to get this Certificate – why not put it to your committee?
