Kumihimo is a Japanese form of braiding fine threads and cords together, resulting in aesthetically pleasing and thicker braids.

In this workshop, we will be working with various thickness of threads and cords. We will start with a simple braid and make a keyring/bag charm/zipper pull. We will then move on to a more elaborate braid for either a necklace or bracelet. Our trio of makes will be completed with a beaded bookmark.



You will need some manual dexterity to thread small beads into fine cord but other than that it isn't complicated. Participants will need to purchase a foam disc which can be purchased easily online. The best-known brand is 'Beadsmith'. You can opt for a 6" or 4" diameter, there's no difference in use. The cost of the disc is around £5.

The cost for a pack of materials for all three projects is £7 and is payable to the tutor on the day. This workshop will be available to book on our website from Monday 31st March.
