NATIONAL MEMORIAL ARBORETUM

The National Memorial Arboretum is an evolving development and much has changed since our last visit seven years ago. In view of the centenary of the ending of WW1, we thought it was timely to revisit this 150-acre site, which presents a tapestry of human stories, tales of heroism and valour, rich in design and symbolism. A visit can stem from the need for a personal pilgrimage, for the historical and cultural experience or just to enjoy art in a beautiful wooded landscape. There are now more facilities on site, including a restaurant and coffee shop, guided walks are available twice a day at a cost of £3 and a land train ride at a cost of £5 – these can be booked on the day by individuals on arrival.

We would like to arrive in time for the 11am service and as it is a long journey, the coaches will depart from **Leyland only at 8.00am**. There is plenty of parking there and an opportunity for people to use the facilities before we set off. There will also be a comfort stop en route. We will leave the Arboretum at approximately 4.30pm.
