Following the WI constitutional changes formalised in June 2025, WIs have the autonomy on the issue of the WI proportion of the membership fee known as the flexibility policy. The Board of Trustees have agreed that WIs should also have autonomy with regard to the pro-rata calculation of their fee for multi-members, meaning that each WI can define what it charges with regard to its proportion for primary and multi-members, up to the limit set by NFWI and applied fairly across all its members.
