A walking Treasure Hunt has been arranged around the small town of Garstang, an ancient market town within the Wyre Borough of Lancashire.

The walk will be in 2 sessions and will commence from the Royal Oak in Garstang, a 17th-century public house whose famous visitor includes Sir Walter Scott in 1828.

A light meal of sandwiches and chips is included in the price. Please state any dietary requirements at the time of booking, i.e., (veg/gluten-free).

Teams can be allocated on the day.

DIRECTIONS

From the M6 at Broughton, follow the A6 until you come to a turn-off for Catterall. After this, follow the Garstang Road all the way until you come to Garstang. Head for the town centre and enter the main high street which is a one-way system. As you near the end, there is a fork in the road where you can see the pub immediately opposite. Take the right fork and turn into the car park at the rear of the pub where you can park your cars.

If travelling from the M6 junction at Lancaster, again follow the A6 until you come to a set of traffic lights, where you turn left. There is a caravan site on the right-hand side. Then continue to follow the one-way system as referenced above.
