The plan is to visit the Historic Buildings at Stonyhurst College, exploring the rich history of the school, including the Elizabethan era "Stonyhurst Hall". It will also include notable rooms such as the Bayley Room, the Great Hall, the Long Room and the Philosophers' Common Room. See Oliver Cromwell's table, as well as the beautiful 19th Century chapels, among other highlights. Refreshments of tea/coffee and biscuits will be served after the visit.

Stonyhurst College is a leading co-educational Catholic Boarding and Day School for 800, 3-18-year-olds. It is situated in a Grade 1 listed building and is 400 years old. Learn about the history, ethos and Mission of this old school with its Jesuit profile.
