It will also include notable rooms such as the Bayley Room, the Great Hall, the Long Room and the Philosophers’ Common Room. See Oliver Cromwell’s table, as well as the beautiful 19th Century chapels, among other highlights. Refreshments of tea/coffee and biscuits will be served after the visit.
