Llandudno is a coastal town in north Wales. It's known for North Shore Beach and 19th-century Pier, with shops and a games arcade. Northwest of the town, the cliffs of Great Orme 679ft headland, jut into the sea. Ancient tunnels lead to a cavern at Great Orme Mines. A 1902 tramway and cable car opened in 1969 both climb a mile high to the headland's summit, where you can take in breath-taking views of Llandudno, areas of Snowdonia national park, the Isle of Anglesey and the Irish Sea. The complex offers a café and visitors centre. To the east, the smaller headland Little Orme is a nature reserve. Mostyn St. Lots to do – the choice is yours!

The coaches will depart from **Carnforth at 8am, Barton 8.45am and Leyland 9.15am.** We will leave Llandudno at approximately 5pm
