

Make and Create Team Christmas Patchwork with Debbie Northin Saturday 8th November 2025 £20.00

A course for intermediate patch workers and quilters who have already tried this craft and have the required equipment and understanding to learn new skills. Not suitable for a beginner, but an experienced quilter

may enjoy making the blocks in good company.



On the day, 2 different blocks will be taught. The blocks will have a Christmas theme (though not religious), and these blocks can then be used to make a table runner and/or table mats for a Christmas table. Having completed two blocks, almost any project can then be done at home if wished, from a small hanging to a full bedspread.

The materials and equipment list:-

Sewing machine, extension lead, cutting mat, pressing mat and small patchwork iron, plus the usual rotary cutter, quilting rulers, threads, etc. The blocks will be calculated for use of Fat Quarters, making the buying of fabric simpler, although you may prefer to cut from your own stash of fabrics.
