Conditions of Entry – Season 2 2026

Dates and Times

Games consist of **2 x 17-minute halves** with a **3-minute halftime**.

Games are scheduled on **Sundays** at:

8:30am, 9:15am, 10am, 11am, 11:45am, and 12:30pm

Key Season Dates – All Age Divisions (Sunday Competition)

Key Event	Date

Team Nominations Close	Friday 14 August 2026
Round 1	Sunday 23 August 2026
Number of Rounds	10 weeks
Grand Finals (U12, U14/U16 & Adults)	Sunday 22 November 2026

Important Notes:

- U6, U8 and U10 do **not** play finals.
- Grading games will be conducted if required
- Finals will 1 vs 2 in U12, U14/U16 and Adults
- Points: Win – 3 points, Draw – 2 points, Loss – 1 point, Forfeit – 0 points

Age Divisions

Division	Eligible Birth Year
Under 6	Must be born in or after 2020
Under 8	Must be born in or after 2018
Under 10	Must be born in or after 2016
Under 12	Must be born in or after 2014
Under 14/Under 16	Must be born in or after 2010
Opens	Must be in or before 2014

Team Fees and Registration

- Players must be registered prior to taking the field for their first game
- Players registered by 14th July 2026 will automatically receive a \$5 discount
- All registered players must also pay a \$52 QTF + TFA annual membership fee.

Division	Team Fee
Under 6	\$95 per player (10 weeks)
Under 8	\$95 per player (10 rounds)
Under 10	\$95 per player (10 rounds)
Under 12	\$105 per player (10 rounds + Finals)
Under 14/Under 16	\$105 per player (10 rounds + Finals)
Opens	\$110 per player (10 rounds + Finals)



Player Registration & Multiple Teams

- Players must register before their first game
- Registration closes after Round 3
- Players cannot play down an age group but may play up
- Playing in multiple teams is allowed however players are unable to play in two teams in the same division
- All players must be registered into the specific team they are playing for. No fill ins are allowed
- Any teams to be playing non-registered players after Round 3 will result in the game being a forfeit

Uniform

All players must wear:

- ✓ A matching shirt or singlet
- ✓ With a **unique number (1 or 2 digits)**
- ✓ All players must wear closed in footwear

Players not in correct uniform must hire a bib from WMTA.

Forfeits

Teams must notify WMTA of a forfeit by no later than 7pm on the Saturday night before the game via admin@wynnummanlytouch.com.au

- Late forfeits may result in loss of competition points or further penalties.
- Teams forfeiting more than 3 times in a season may face exclusion from the competition
- Teams must have at least 4 registered players to take the field, any less will result in a forfeit

Team Delegate/Coaches Responsibilities

The Team Delegate/Coaches must ensure:

- All players are eligible and registered
- They have A Working with Children Check (Blue Card)
- A responsible adult (18+) is present for all games
- Compliance with the TFA Code of Conduct
- Team fees are paid by the scheduled deadline
- Players are familiar with:
 - TFA 8th Edition Playing Rules
 - WMTA General Conditions of Entry
 - These competition rules
 - Uniform requirements
